Health Hazards (Acute and Chronic): Rout(s) of Entry/Signs and Symptoms of Exposure

May cause burns to skin and eyes, fumes may be irritating and harmful. Vapors have anesthetic affect - headache, nausea and dizziness. Harmful if swallowed.

Emergency and First Aid Procedures

If skin contact occurs, flush with water for 10 minutes. If dryness develops, use skin lotion. If eye contact occurs, flush with water for 10 minutes. If irritation persists, consult a physician. Use only with adequate ventilation. If fumes are inhaled, remove to fresh air. If ingested, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician.
